

Ecuador - Galapagos Islands Oil Spill

An estimated 650,000 litres (144,000 gallons) of fuel oil and Bunker C (a heavier oil) have leaked into the sea after a ship ran aground on San Cristobal Island.

Ecuador has made an appeal for international assistance on 21 January 2001.

A joint UNEP/OCHA Environmental Unit has been mobilized.
