SUMMARY OF IMPORTANT EVENTS AS ON 25.08.2009

RAINFALL/FLOOD SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY

UTTAR PRADESH

- **Light rainfall** has been reported in some parts of the State during last **24 hours**.

ASSAM

- **Light rainfall** has been reported in some parts of the State during last **24 hours**.

BIHAR

- **Light rainfall** has been reported in some parts of the State during last **24 hours**.

ORISSA

- **No significant rainfall** has been reported in the State during last **24 hours**.

KERALA

- **No significant rainfall** has been reported in the State during **last 24 hours**.
- **02 human deaths** have been reported in the State during last **24 hours**.

GUJARAT

- **No significant rainfall** has been reported in the State during last **24 hours**.

KARNATAKA

- **Moderate to heavy with isolated very heavy rainfall** at a few places has been reported in the State during **last 24 hours**.

HUMAN DEATHS

- Government of Uttar Pradesh has raised the number of human lives lost from 31 to 155 in their report dated 25.08.2009. As per provisional information received from the affected States/UTs, the total death toll has risen to **861** from **735**.

IMD

- **Fairly widespread rainfall activity with isolated heavy to very heavy fall** is likely over **Orissa, Chhattisgarh** and **north Andhra Pradesh** during next **48 hours** and **decrease thereafter**.
- **The rainfall activity** is likely to **increase over Madhya Pradesh** from **tomorrow** and over **Maharashtra, Goa** and **Gujarat** from

27th onwards with **isolated heavy to very heavy falls**. There is also a possibility of **isolated extremely heavy rainfall (≥ 25 cm)** over **Konkan Goa and south Gujarat around 28th**.

CENTRAL WATER COMMISSION

- There are **21 Moderate flood** situation sites in the country.

INDIA METEOROLOGICAL DEPARTMENT

Monsoon Watch

- **A low pressure area** has formed **over northwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining coastal Orissa**.
- **Chief amounts of rainfall (≥ 5 cm)** recorded at 0830 hours IST of today is: **Agumbe-16, Pune (Airport) and Parbhani-10, Gulberga, Mahabaleshwar, Mangalore and Panambur-7** each, **Mumbai, Honavar and Shirali, Bidar-7** each, **Marmugoa, Karwar, Ratnagiri and Goa (Abolim)-5** each.

Main features

- **Fairly widespread rainfall activity** with **isolated heavy to very heavy fall** is likely over **Orissa, Chhattisgarh and north Andhra Pradesh** during next **48 hours** and **decrease thereafter**.
- **The rainfall activity** is likely to **increase over Madhya Pradesh** from **tomorrow** and over **Maharashtra, Goa and Gujarat** from **27th onwards** with **isolated heavy to very heavy falls**. There is also a possibility of **isolated extremely heavy rainfall (≥ 25 cm)** over **Konkan Goa and south Gujarat around 28th**.

Warning

- **Isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall** is likely over **Orissa, Chhattisgarh, south Madhya Pradesh, Madhya Maharashtra, Maradwada, Vidarbha, north Andhra Pradesh, Konkan, Goa and coastal Karnataka**.

Weather outlook for next two days

- **Decrease in rainfall activity** over **central India and interior Maharashtra**.
- **Widespread rainfall activity** with **heavy to very heavy fall** at a **few places** and **isolated extremely heavy fall (≥ 25 cm)** is likely over **Konkan Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and south Gujarat**.

CENTRAL WATER COMMISSION

According to the **Central Water Commission (CWC)** report dated **25th August, 2009**, there are **21 Moderate flood situation sites (Assam -06, Bihar-10, Uttar Pradesh -04 and West Bengal-01)** in the country. At present, no river is in unprecedented/high flood situation site in the country.

UTTAR PRADESH

- **Light rainfall** has been reported in some parts of the State during last **24 hours**.
- **Total 155 human deaths** have been reported in the State so far. **No human death** has been reported during last **24 hours**.
- **95 livestock** have perished so far.
- **About 11.85 lakh people** in **13 districts** are reported to have been affected.
- **About 2263 villages** are reported to have been affected and **261** villages have been marooned.
- **About 4.55 lakh ha** cropped area are reported to have been affected.
- **About 2414 houses** (fully-**610** & partially-**1804**) have been damaged.
- **About 82905 people** have been evacuated so far.
- **1882 boats** have been deployed in the affected areas for rescue and relief operations.
- **171 relief camps** have been opened in the affected areas in which about **36586 people** are accommodated.

ASSAM

- **Light rainfall** has been reported in some parts of the State during last **24 hours**.
- **Total 08 human deaths** have been reported in the State so far. **No human death** has been reported during last **24 hours**.
- **About 6,40,488 people** are reported to have been affected.
- **443 livestock** have perished so far.

BIHAR

- **Light rainfall** has been reported in some parts of the State during last **24 hours**.
- **Total 08 human deaths** have been reported in the State so far. **No human death** has been reported during last **24 hours**.
- **3519 people** have been evacuated so far.
- **141 health** centers have also been opened.
- **24 government boats** and **427 private boats** have been pressed into service for rescue and relief operations.

ORISSA

- **No significant rainfall** has been reported in the State during last **24 hours**.
- **Total 56 human deaths** have been reported in the State so far. **No human death** has been reported during last **24 hours**.
- **19454 livestock** have perished so far.
- **About 3,84,000 people** are reported to have been affected.

- **About 1,26,000 ha** cropped area are reported to have been affected.
- **About 12547 houses** (fully-**870** & partially-**11677**) have been damaged.
- **About 62200 people** have been evacuated so far.
- **82 boats** have been deployed in the affected areas for rescue and relief operations.
- **80 relief camps** have been opened in the affected areas in which about **64346 people** are accommodated.
- **Medical centres** have been opened and medical teams have also been deployed for providing medical aid to the people in the flood affected areas.

KERALA

- **No significant rainfall** has been reported in the State during **last 24 hours**.
- **127 human deaths** have been reported in the State so far. **02 human deaths** have been reported during last **24 hours**.
- **164 cattle/livestock** have perished.
- **About 12,21,285 people** are reported to have been affected.
- **25947.94 ha** cropped area are reported to have been affected.
- **About 22424 houses** (fully-**1214** & partially-**21210**) have been damaged.
- **03 relief camps** have been opened in the affected areas in which about **71 people** are accommodated.
- Food and medicines are being distributed to the people accommodated in the relief camps.

GUJARAT

- **No significant rainfall** has been reported in the State during last **24 hours**.
- **82 human deaths** have been reported in the State so far. **No human death** has been reported during last **24 hours**.
- **439 livestock** have perished.
- **About 6,33,981 people** are reported to have been affected.
- **2926 ha** cropped area have affected.
- **12539 houses** (fully-**771** & partially-**11768**) have been damaged.
- **95 relief camps** have been opened in the affected areas in which about **24131 people** are accommodated.
- **08 boats** have been deployed in the flood affected areas.
- **54 medical teams & 09 veterinary teams** have also been deployed in the affected areas.

KARNATAKA

- **Moderate to heavy with isolated very heavy rainfall** at a few places has been reported in the State during **last 24 hours**.
- **109 human deaths** have been reported so far in the State. **No human death** has been reported during last **24 hours**.

- **About 2,17,000 people in 252 villages and 14 districts** are reported to have affected.
- **1161 cattle/livestock** are reported to have been perished.
- **137230 ha** cropped area have affected.
- **10877 houses** (fully–**216** & partially–**10661**) have been damaged.

**DEPLOYMENT OF NATIONAL DISASTER RESPONSE FORCE (NDRF)
ON 25th AUGUST, 2009**

- ❖ **In Assam, 03 teams** consisting of **107 personnel (N/Lakhimpur-02, Barpeta & Barpeta-01 each)** alongwith equipment have been deployed in the affected areas.
- ❖ **In West Bengal, 01 coy** consisting of **39 personnel** alongwith equipment have been deployed in **Kurseaong** district.
- ❖ **In Maharashtra, 01 coy & 01 team (Nanded – 01 coy and Amravati – 01 team)** consisting of **86 personnel** alongwith equipment deployed in the State.
- ❖ **In Bihar, 03 coys (01 coy each in Darbhanga, Kishanganj & Begusarai) & 01 team (Bihta-01)** consisting of **191 personnel** alongwith equipment have been deployed in the districts.
- ❖ **In Kerala, 01 team in Calicut (Kozikode)** district consisting of **31 personnel** alongwith equipment has been deployed in the district for relief and rescue operations.
