

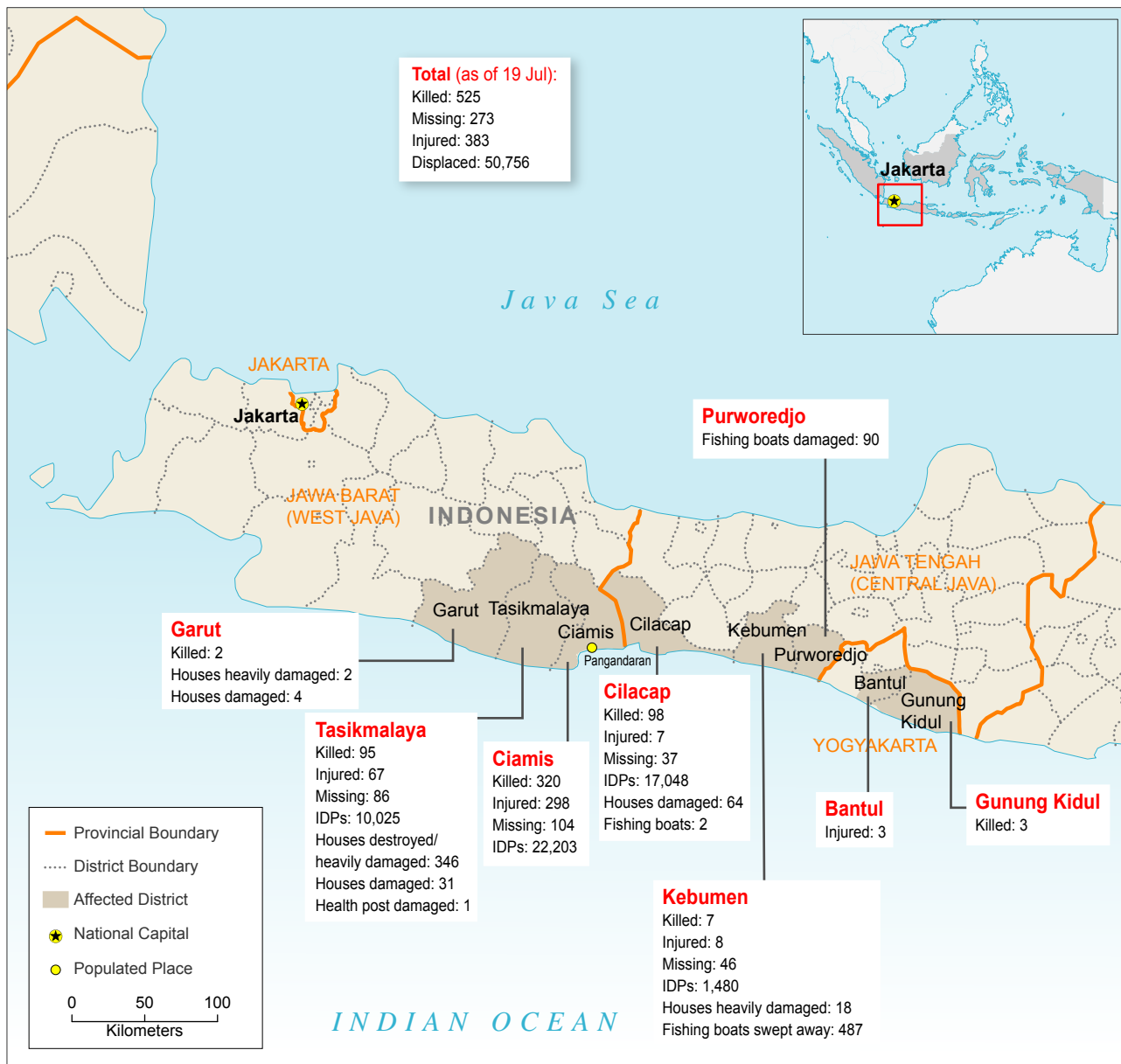


Indonesia: West Java Earthquake and Tsunami

SITUATION

M7.2 earthquake struck West Java on 17 July followed by a tsunami. According to the Indonesian Red Cross (PMI/IFRC), all affected areas are accessible. Electricity and communication systems are functioning.

ACTION

National Response

National Government deploying medical teams and providing emergency funds and relief supplies to local governments. 15 evacuation sites established by provincial government in West Java.

International Response

UNICEF emergency assistance supplies arriving today (19 July). WHO conducting needs assessments with UN Country Team and provincial and national health offices; and deploying mobile health units to affected areas. OXFAM providing clean water to two IDP sites in Pangandaran.
