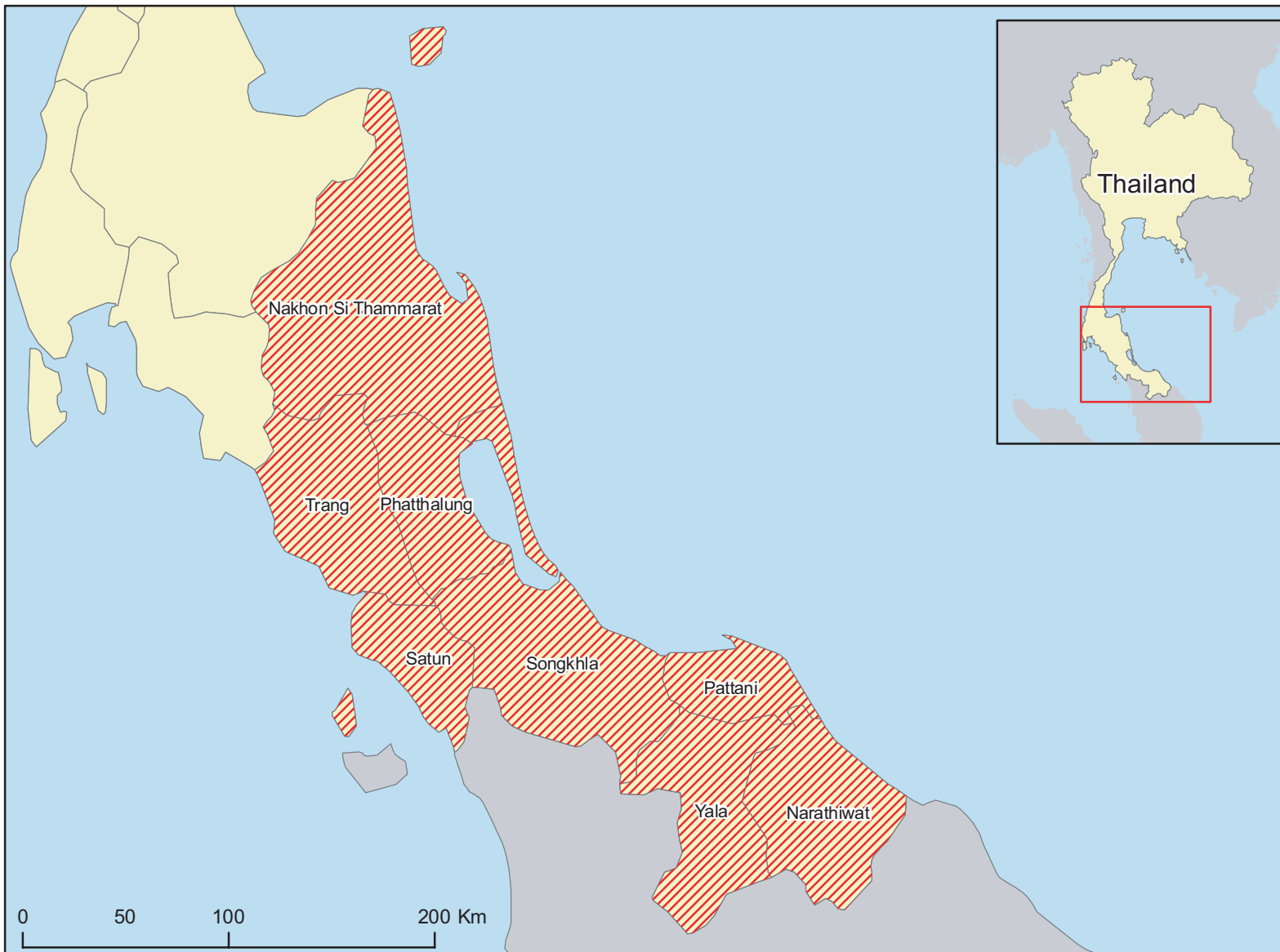




Southern Thailand: Floods



Between 13 and 22 December 2005, the Thai Red Cross national headquarters and the provincial chapters have in total provided 26,300 kits of relief items to the affected population in the seven southern provinces. The relief items consisted of drinking water, salt, canned foods, first aid kits, candles, lighters, plastic bags, household medicines and medicines for foot disease.

At least 25 people were drowned and some 368,500 families were affected by the flash floods. More than 80 % of the total areas in some localities were inundated.
