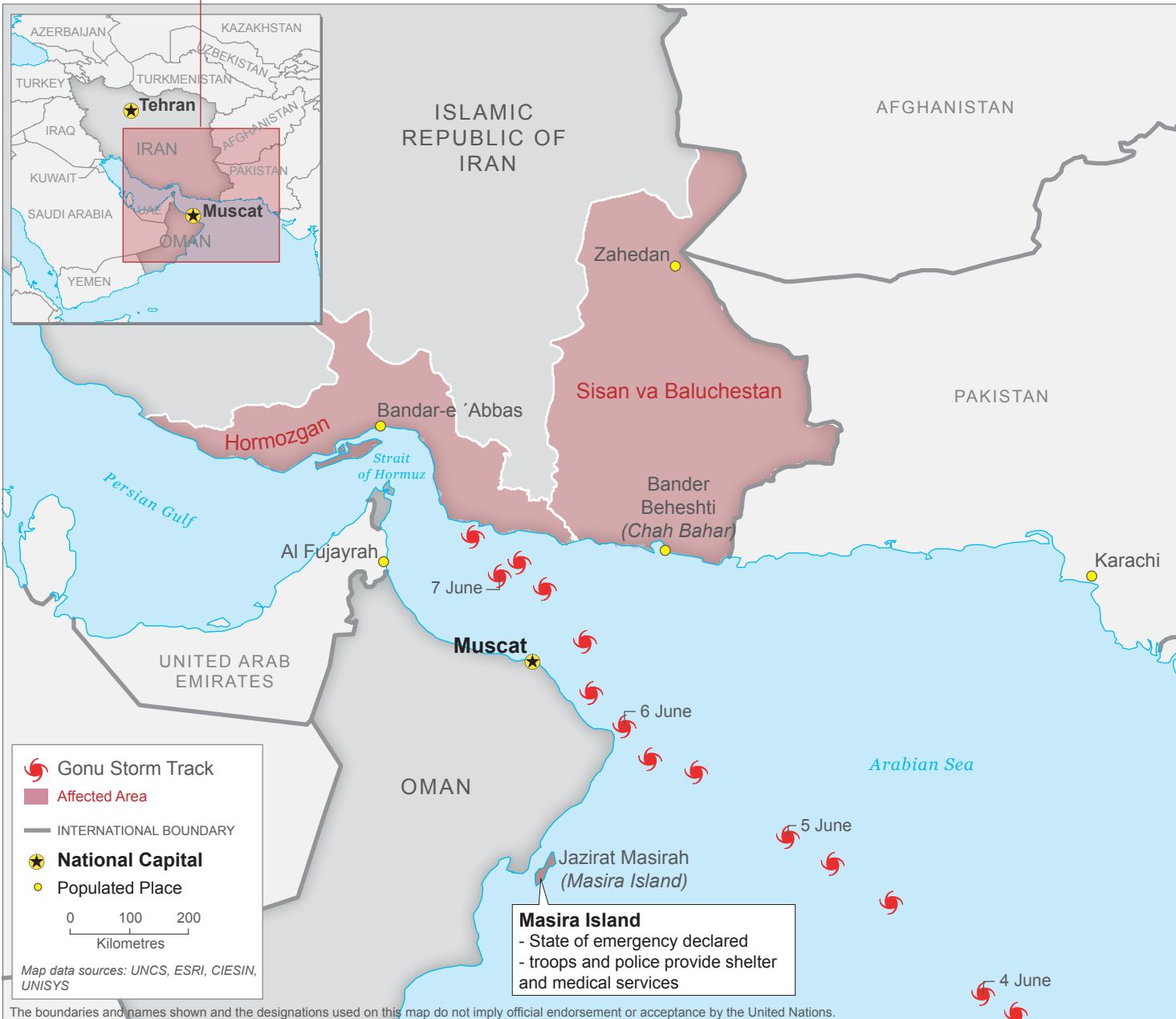


# Oman/Iran: Cyclone Gonu

Cyclone Gonu reached Oman's coast Wednesday 6 June with fierce winds and torrential rains, forcing thousands from their homes. The cyclone has carried on to the Iranian southern coast. 15 killed. 60,000 evacuated.

## SITUATION

- 12 deaths in Oman
- No electricity in Muscat on Wednesday, and streets and buildings flooded
- 20,000 evacuated and housed in government-provided dwellings, stocked with medicine and supplies
- Another two islands completely evacuated
- 3 killed and 9 injured in Iran
- 11 cities and ports in Iran's southern provinces have been affected
- Authorities evacuated hundreds of people living in Chah Bahar

## ACTION

- Over 4,000 civil defense personnel deployed in affected areas of Oman
- Government of Oman said its own national resources are adequate for time being
- Government of Iran, the National Disaster Task Force and the Iranian Red Crescent Society (IRCS) fully mobilized
- IRCS dispatched equipment and relief workers
- For both countries, no request for international assistance and situation well under control
